

CODE OF CONDUCT: (Course)

Introduction

This code of conduct sets out the behaviour expected of all members, patrons and guests playing golf at Gosford Golf Club. Club staff are authorised to approach any player or person who behaves in a manner that does not adhere to either clubhouse or course code of conducts.

General requirements:

Gosford Golf Club will not tolerate:

- 1. Any conduct considered threatening, harassing or any behaviour that could threaten the physical or emotional safety of another individual
- 2. Inappropriate expressions of anger and vulgar or abusive language
- 3. Abuse of clubs or throwing towards another player
- 4. Being disrespectful or deliberately distracting other players
- 5. Any conduct resulting in damage to the property of Gosford Golf Club
- 6. Violation of the club's dress codes
- 7. Intoxication
- 8. Other such behaviour that falls short of the standards of etiquette and behaviour outlined in the Rules of Golf (1.2)
- 9. Any members, patrons, guests or committee-persons approaching an employee of the Club to reprimand, give directions or instructions regarding the manner of work or terms of employment.

Reports of alleged unacceptable conduct must be reported to the Club Captain or the General Manager on the day of the offence or as soon as practical

<u>Note:</u>

Any player believed to be in the possession of alcohol within the club or on the golf course not purchased from Gosford Golf Club will be required to return the alcohol to their vehicle in the car park & or leave the club or course immediately.

In the event of a breach by a member or visitor, Gosford Golf Club reserves the right to discipline the offender as per its Constitution.
